

Privacy Policy

1. The information below applies to personal information (information about an identifiable individual) we, Chelsea Anastasia, collect about you when you visit and browse our website. In addition to our Privacy Policy you should also read our Terms and Conditions.
 2. We collect personal information from you including your registration details and information relating to your use of the website and the content you access.
 3. We may use this personal information to help us provide the Services to you, to contact you, to send you information about us and third parties, to verify your identity, to enforce or apply our terms and conditions, to protect the rights of Chelsea Anastasia and for any other use that you authorise.
 4. We will release account and other personal information only if we consider release is appropriate for legal compliance and law enforcement (including to government agencies with statutory law enforcement responsibilities or to facilitate court proceedings) or to enforce or apply our terms and conditions or to protect the rights of Chelsea Anastasia, our users or others.
 5. When you visit our website or use our Services we also collect some non-personal information, such as the IP address from which you access our website, the date and time you are visiting, the pages you accessed, the type of browser and operating system you use, and terms you use to search for content on our site. This information cannot be used to personally identify you. We use it for the purposes of system administration, auditing use of the site and improving it for different customer profiles, and for our internal reporting.
 6. When you provide us with personal information, we are obliged to comply with the provisions of the Privacy Act 2020 (the "Act"). We will collect, hold, use and disclose that information in accordance with the principles set out in the Act. This means we will:
 - a. use personal information only for the purpose we collect it for;
 - b. retain that information only for so long as necessary to fulfil the purpose for which we have collected it;
 - c. disclose or release it to a third party only where we are required to or we are permitted by law to do so, if you have authorised the release or disclosure, or where it is the purpose (or a directly related purpose) for which the information was collected.
